Dear Sirs:

The Commissioners Court of Upshur County having reviewed the proposed 1983-84 budget of the Upshur County Appraisal District wishes to express to the Board of Directors their concern on several entries within the budget .

1. Mapping supplies for 1982-83 showed an expenditure of \$1,500.00. The 1983-84 budget proposed an expenditure of \$13,500.00. Please explain.
2. We feel the total increase in cost from 1982-83 budget to 1983-84 budget of \$52,830.00 for a percentage increase of 18.1% to be excessive.
3. The Court feels that Upshur County's portion of the budget increase is excessive.
1982-83 a total of \$69,635.00
1983-84 a total of \$99,225.00
This is an increase of \$29,590.00 and a percentage increase of 42.5%..

The Court would call to the Boards attention that the Upshur County Appraisal District does no collecting processes for Upshur County.

The budget shows \$9,600.00 salary for a collection department head, one clerk and part time clerks for a salary value of \$26,200.00. The County feels Upshur County should be exempt, at this time, from paying any part of these salaries.

We would ask the Upshur County Appraisal District budget to show a break out of these charges to the participating entities.

The Upshur County Commissioners Court fully realizes the tremendous job the Board and its staff of the Upshur County Appraisal District has done. We feel both the Board and staff should be commended for putting forth the effort necessary to accomplish a very complicated task.
