Court reconvened, and again Judge Dean gave the opportunity for the citizens present to comment. No comments were made.

Commissioner Paul Davis read to the court a proposed resolution concerning the detachment of a portion of the Union Grove School District as described by the metes and bounds; and this portion be annexed into the Gilmer Ind. School District. Motion by Paul Davis seconded by J.W. Meadows to accept and record in the minutes the resolution. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Mr. Bednar requested from the court copies of the resolution and the order approving the resolution. He also requested that the Motion for Continuance he presented to the court be placed in the minutes.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Paul Davis to recess and draft a court order. Motion carried.

Court reconvened

Judge Dean read the Order to the court. Motion by Paul Davis seconded by J.W. Meadows to approve the order as read. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Paul Davis to recess until Wednesday August 3rd, at 1:00. Motion carried.

MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF UNION GROVE  
INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Board of Trustees of the Union Grove Independent School District respectfully moves the Court for a continuance of the public hearing scheduled in the above-entitled matter, and in support of said motion would show the Court:

I.

The above-entitled petition was filed on July 25, 1983. The Board of Trustees of the Union Grove Independent School District has never been formally served with a copy of the petition, but did obtain a copy upon its own request on July 25, 1983. By letter dated July 26, 1983, the Union Grove Independent School District requested at least ten days notice in advance of the date and time of the hearing in order to prepare and present its case.

II.

On August 1, 1983, the undersigned received a letter dated July 29, 1983, from the Honorable Everett Dean, County Judge of Upshur County, setting a public hearing on the petition for August 2, 1983, at 9:00 a.m., in the County Courtroom.

III.

In order to present a defense to this petition, it will be necessary for the Union Grove Independent School District to verify exactly the signatures on the petition, the metes and bounds of the area sought to be detached, the number of students residing in the area to be detached, the number of students residing in the Union Grove Independent School District, the assessed valuation of the area to be detached, and the assessed valuation of the Union Grove Independent School District. It will also be necessary to marshal other important evidence relating to school transportation, educational opportunities, adjustment of bonded indebtedness, and other fiscal considerations. The Union Grove Independent School District has not had

an adequate opportunity to prepare its case and is in need of a reasonable time in which to prepare these matters for presentation to the Commissioners' Court.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Board of Trustees of the Union Grove Independent School District respectfully requests that the public hearing on the above-entitled petition be continued and rescheduled at some time and date between August 10 and August 17, 1983.



RESOLUTION BY THE COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS COURT, UPSHUR  
COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas has been duly petitioned to detach from the Union Grove Independent School District certain territory; and to annex said territory to the Gilmer Independent School District, a copy of which petition is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the population of Upshur County is less than 100,000 according to the last preceding federal census and that the Gilmer Independent School District has less than 30,220 scholastics according to the last official scholastic census; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that said territory is contiguous to the common boundary line of the Union Grove Independent School District and Gilmer Independent School District, and

WHEREAS, THE Commissioners Court has determined that said petition requesting detachment and annexation is signed by a majority of the qualified voters residing in the territory to be detached from the Union Grove Independent School District and added to the Gilmer Independent School District; and said petition gives the metes and bounds of the territory to be detached from the Union Grove Independent School District and added to the Gilmer Independent School District, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the proposed annexation has been approved by a majority of the Board of Trustees of the Gilmer Independent School District by resolution passed in special session on July 22, 1983, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the ratio of the number of scholastics residing in the territory to be detached to the total number of the scholastics residing in the territory to be detached to the total number of the scholastics residing in the Union Grove Independent School District is more than one half the ratio of the assessed valuation (based on the preceding year valuation in the territory to be detached) to the total assessed valuation (based on the preceding year valuations) of the Union Grove Independent School District, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that detachment of said territory from Union Grove Independent School District would not reduce any school district to an area of less than nine square miles, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has upon receipt of said petition and notice of approval by the Board of Trustees of the Gilmer Independent School District given public notice including notice to the trustees of any other common school districts which may be affected by any change contemplated and that said public notice specified the place and date at which a hearing would be held and at which the trustees of any common school district would be given an opportunity to be heard, and

WHEREAS the Commissioners Court has taken into consideration the value of the school properties and the taxable wealth of the districts affected and territory to be detached and added, and has arrived at an equitable adjustment of the indebtedness and the district properties between the districts affected and between the territory detached and added, and


WHEREAS the Commissioners Court has conducted and concluded a hearing pursuant to the Texas Education Code Section 19.261,

WHEREFORE BY IT RESOLVED that the territory described by said petition be detached from the Union Grove School District and annexed to the Gilmer Independent School District and that the boundaries of the Union Grove Independent School District and the Gilmer Independent School District be redefined in accordance with said detachment and annexation.

LET IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any indebtedness heretofore incurred by the Union Grove Independent School District remain the sole indebtedness of the Union Grove Independent School District as redefined, that any funds now held by the Union Grove Independent School District remain as assets of the Union Grove Independent School District, that the territory detached from the Union Grove Independent School District shall hereafter bear no indebtedness heretofore incurred by the Union Grove Independent School District and that the Union Grove Independent School District shall not be obligated to assume any indebtedness heretofore incurred by the Union Grove Independent School District.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Honorable Court acting as ex officio county board of education immediately order said detachment and annexation in accordance with the Texas Education Code Sections 19.261, 19.331 et. seq. and 19.431 et. seq.; and cause said order to be recorded in the minutes of the Court.

SAID DISTRICTS AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS  
RELATING THERETO AND ENACTING PROVISIONS  
INCIDENT AND RELATING THEREOF

COUNTY OF UPSHUR

ON THIS the 2nd day of August, 1983 the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, acting as ex officio County Board of Education duly convened in special session at the regular meeting place of said Court with the following members present and in attendance, Everett Dean, County Judge; Delmo Lawson, Commissioner Precinct 1; J. W. Meadows, Commissioner Precinct 2; Charles Still, Commissioner Precinct 3 and Paul Davis, Commissioner Precinct 4 and with the following absent none constituting a quorum. Others present were Ed Burleson, Superintendent of Union Grove Independent School District; William C. Bednar, attorney representing Union Grove Independent School District Trustees; Jack Cockrill, Superintendent of Gilmer Independent School District; Norton Lovell, Superintendent of New Diana Independent District; and Tommy Ferguson, Superintendent of Ore City Independent School District.

WHEREUPON a hearing was held in accordance with the provision of Texas Education Code Section 19.261 at the conclusion of which the County Judge placed before the Court the following order relating to detaching territory from the Union Grove Independent School District of Upshur County, Texas and annexing said territory to the Gilmer Independent School District of Upshur County, Texas redefining boundaries of said districts and making certain findings relating thereto and enacting provisions incident and relating thereof.

PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Court makes the following findings of fact:

THAT on the 25 day of July, 1983 the County Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas was duly petitioned to detach from the Union Grove Independent School District certain territory; and to annex said territory to the Gilmer Independent School District, a copy of which petition is attached hereto; and

THAT the population of Upshur County is less than 100,000 according to the last preceding federal census and that the Gilmer Independent School District has less than 30,220 scholastics according to the last official scholastic census; and

THAT said territory is contiguous to the common boundary line of the Union Grove Independent School District and Gilmer Independent School District, and

THAT said petition requesting detachment and annexation is signed by a majority of the qualified voters residing in the territory to be detached from the Union Grove Independent School District and added to the Gilmer Independent School District; and said petition gives the metes and bounds of the territory to be detached from the Union Grove Independent School District and added to the Gilmer Independent School District, and

THAT the proposed annexation has been approved by a majority of the Board of Trustees of the Gilmer Independent School District by resolution passed in special session on July 22, 1983, and

THAT the ratio of the number of scholastics residing in the territory to be detached to the total number of the scholastics residing in the territory to be detached to the total number of the scholastics residing in the Union Grove Independent School District is more than one half the ratio of the assessed valuation (based on the preceding year valuation in the territory to be detached) to the total assessed valuation (based on the preceding year valuations) of the Union Grove Independent School District, and

THAT detachment of said territory from Union Grove Independent School District and annexation of said territory to Gilmer Independent School District would not reduce any school district to an area of less than nine square miles, and

THAT the Commissioners Court has upon receipt of said petition and notice of approval by the Board of Trustees of the Gilmer Independent School District given public notice including notice to the trustees of any other common school districts which may be affected by any change contemplated and that said public notice specified the place and date at which a hearing would be held and at which the trustees of any common school district would be given opportunity to be heard, and

THAT the Commissioners Court has taken into consideration the value of the school properties and the taxable wealth of the districts affected and territory to be detached and added, and has arrived at an equitable adjustment of the indebtedness and the district properties between the districts affected and between the territory detached and added; therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS ACTING AS EX OFFICIO COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION:

SECTION I. The recitals contained in the preamble of this order are hereby found as a fact and incorporated herein and adopted as a part of this order as though set out at length as a part of this section.

SECTION II. That the territory described as follows:

Lying and being situated wholly within Upshur County, Texas, and:

BEGINNING at the Northeast corner of the old Mings Chapel Common School District No. 23 of Upshur County, Texas, said point lying in the South line of Gilmer Independent School District and being the most Westerly Northwest corner of the East Mountain Independent School District and said point being 175 varas North of the Northwest corner

of a tract of land on the A. Lumbrera HR Survey known as the John Kemp place and now owned by Glen Arrington, said Arrington land lying immediately East of the Gilmer Country Club;

THENCE South at 175 vrs pass said corner and at 1497 vrs the North line of a HR Survey in the name of G. W. Crow;

THENCE East with the North line of said Crow HR Survey 143 vrs to the NE corner of said Crow Survey and the NWC of a tract of land on the S. M. Smith Survey known as the Bob Beasley place;

THENCE South with the West line of said Beasley place and the West line of a tract of land on the Malinda Thornton HR Survey owned by Futrell Bros. at 2208 vrs the SWC of said tract in the North line of a survey in the name of Simpson Brown;

THENCE East with said line and the North line of a tract once owned by Mr. Nations 160 vrs to the NWC of a 200 acre tract on said Brown HR Survey once owned by L. F. Smart;

THENCE South with the West line of said Smart tract at 1374 vrs pass the SWC of same and at 3023 vrs a stake in the North line of a survey in the name of Robt. Burton and better known as the John Mitchell land;

THENCE East with the North line of same 896 vrs to the NEC of said Survey;

THENCE South 1900 vrs with the EBL of the Burton Survey to the SEC of same;

THENCE West 1900 vrs with the SBL of the Burton Survey to the SWC of the Burton Survey, same being the EBL of the JBB Davenport Survey;

THENCE South 7365 vrs along the EBL of the Davenport Survey to the SEC of same, also being the NEC of the Augustine Survey;

THENCE W with N line of said Augustine Survey to a point which is the SEC of the Mary L. Langham 49.6 acre tract and the SWC of the Leo A. Wilburn 50 acre tract;

THENCE N with EBL of the Mary Langham tract and continuing North to the NEC of the M. B. Briggs 89.3 acre tract;

THENCE W with Briggs' N line to the SEC of Frank A. Woods' 240 acre tract;

THENCE N. with Woods' E line a distance of 825 vrs to a point in the EBL of Frank A. Woods' 240 acre tract;

THENCE W to the NW corner of Frank Woods' 153 acre tract, said point being in EBL of Dedman and Williams tract now owned by Gladewater Hunting and Fishing Club;

THENCE N with EBL to NEC of Dedman and Williams 253 acre tract;

THENCE W with N line of said tract to a point on the W line of the J.B.B. Davenport Survey, said point being Dedman and Williams' NWC;

THENCE N with W line of J.B.B Davenport Survey to the SWC of W. J. Spencer 82.7 acre tract;

THENCE E with S line of Spencer tract to the SEC of J. A. Sweetman 124.3 acre tract, now owned by Foster Francis;

THENCE N. with Sweetman's E line and continue North to a point in West fork of Pond Creek, said point being the most Southerly NEC of R. W. White's 442 acre tract;

THENCE N and Northwesterly with meanderings of said Pond Creek to a point in WBL of J.B.B. Davenport Survey, same being a point where St. Louis & SW Railroad bridge crossed said creek before said railroad was relocated in about the year 1929;

THENCE North with the WBL of the J. B. B. Davenport Survey to the NWC of a 39 acre tract of land of the I. W. Driggers estate;

THENCE East with the North line of said Driggers 39 acre tract and continuing East a total distance of 1375 vrs to the SEC of the B. F. Humphrey 30 acre tract, said point being the SEC of Block No. 2 of the J.B.B. Davenport HRS;

THENCE North 810 vrs to a point in the East line of Block No. 2 J.B. B. Davenport HRS;

THENCE 3930 vrs along the South line of Gilmer Independent School District to the place of beginning, and containing 21.09 square miles be detached from the Union Grove Independent School District and annexed to the Gilmer Independent School District and that the boundaries of the Union Grove Independent School District and the Gilmer Independent School District are hereby to add said territory to the Gilmer Independent School District and remove said territory from the Union Grove Independent School District.

SECTION III. THAT any indebtedness heretofore incurred by the Union Grove Independent School District remain the sole indebtedness of the Union Grove Independent School District as redefined, that any funds now held by the Union Grove Independent School District remain as assets of the Union Grove Independent School District, that the territory detached from the Union Grove Independent School District shall hereafter bear no indebtedness heretofore incurred by the Union Grove Independent School District and that the Gilmer Independent School District shall not be obligated to assume any indebtedness heretofore incurred by the Union Grove Independent School District.


SECTION IV. THAT the County Clerk of Upshur County is hereby directed to record this order in its entirety in the minutes of this governing board.


