Motion by J.W. Meadows seconded by Paul Davis to approve payment of the land and building for future county facilities.- Motion carried.



Dear Judge Dean:

In connection with Section IV of the Mass Gathering Act, I submit the following information and request that you respectfully consider this as an application for a permit pursuant to Section IV (a) of said Act:

1. The name and address of the "promoter" is Worldwide Church of God.
2. This convention or "Festival" is financed by individual church members and guaranteed by the Worldwide Church of God.
3. The property on which the gathering is to be held is owned by the Worldwide Church of God and Ambassador College.
4. The location of the property on which the gathering is to be held is the campus of Ambassador College, Big Sandy, Texas consisting of approximately 1600 acres.
5. The gathering will be held from the evening of September 21, 1983 through September 29, 1983.
6. The number of persons which promoter will allow to attend the gathering is approximately 7,000 and attendants will be naturally limited in that the gathering is limited to members and guests.
7. Following is a brief statement of the sanitation and health facilities which will be available during the above stated period of time to service those attending the gathering: We will be using our normal state inspected sewage facilities, which meet State requirements, as well as our standard State inspected sanitary land fill. We will have available on campus 556 permanent water closets. Of the 7,000 in attendance, only 5,000 will be staying on the campus grounds.



8. Following is a brief description of the preparations which have been made to provide traffic control and assure the orderly conduct and physical safety of those in attendance: We have notified the Texas Highway Patrol as to the dates involved and have set up an extensive traffic control network on campus headed by a traffic expert. We have established a crew of traffic directors to help control traffic in conjunction with extensive use of directional signs and other traffic equipment.
9. Ambassador College maintains and equips a permanent health station on its campus. A qualified physician and registered nurse and adequate medical supplies will be available to those at the gathering who find a need for them.
10. All minors in attendance at the gathering will be either under the direct supervision of their parents in attendance or under the direct supervision of the administrative staff of the Worldwide Church of God, and will be operating under strict policies of which they are aware and to which they adhere. Which policies are designed to promote and preserve proper moral conduct, compliance with the law and general health and well being.

Please take whatever additional steps necessary, including contacting the County Health Offices, and advise us if your office needs any additional information in connection with the proposed gathering. Feel free to contact me at Ambassador College in Big Sandy, Texas. Our phone number is (214) 636-4311 ext. 531.

We trust that you will be in a position to issue a permit prior to the above indicated date of the forthcoming Festival and we assure you complete cooperation not only on the part of the Worldwide Church of God's personnel, but on the part of all persons who will be in attendance at the forthcoming Festival of the Worldwide Church of God.





It is further agreed and understood between the parties herein that this Interlocal Governmental Agreement shall be for a period of one year from date of execution.


