Commissioners Court met in Special Session with all members of the court present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the October 24th meeting. Motion by J.W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson for the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Judge Dean read a letter to the court from the State Treasury Department, concerning the Lateral Road Fund distributions allocated by the Texas Legislature. Copy attached.

Judge Dean read a letter to the court from the Upshur County Appraisal District concerning Bank Intangibles. Copy attached.

Sheriff Dale Jewkes met with the court concerning increased fees for civil processes. In Small Claims fee from 15.00 dollars to 20.00 dollars. Justice Court from 20.00 dollars to 25.00 dollars. All Summons, Citations and Subpoenas from 25.00 to 35.00 dollars. The service of writs from 27.00 to 50.00 dollars. Posting notices on the court house bulletin board would be dropped from 25.00 to 5.00 dollars. Sheriff Jewkes also proposed charging a 10.00 fee for taking and approving bonds. Motion by Paul Davis seconded by Delmo Lawson to place proposal on next agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Paul Davis to approve raising salaries of Election workers from 4.00 to 5.00 dollars, and an extra 25.00 dollars will be paid for Election Judges. Motion carried.

Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by J.W. Meadows to approve a Permit Application by Mat Tillman to place a water line within the ROW of Buckeye Road. Motion Carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Paul Davis seconded by Charles Still to approve a Permit Application by Don Hayes to place a gas line within the ROW of Shattles Road, with the stipulation that the line must be a least 36" underground. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by Paul Davis to approve a Permit Application by Mrs. Jim Shockey to place a culvert installation within the ROW of Lilac road. Motion Carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Paul Davis seconded by Charles Still to approve a Special Road Use Agreement by McBrayer Oil Corporation for the use of Flying Squirrel Road. Motion carried Copy attached.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson to adopt a Resolution from the Commissioners Court to Mrs Ruth Snow as appreciation for her services as Election Judge of voting Pct. #15. The Motion also included sending Mrs. Snow a copy of the resolution. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by J.W. Meadows to accept a Proclamation from Commissioners court to proclaim November 10, 1983 as Extension Homemaker Day in Upshur County. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Commissioners Court discussed leasing block 78 of the Upshur County School Land in Baylor County with Eldorado Oil and Gas, with the stipulation the lease be for 3 years. Court took no action.

Motion by Paul Davis seconded by J.W. Meadows to approve a contract with Texas Department of Health to provide Health services. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Davis seconded by J.W. Meadows to advertise for bids on Motor Grader for Pct. #4. Bids will be opened November 14. Motion carried.

Commissioners Court opened discussion on the purchase of vehicles for the County Commissioners. Sheriff Dale Jewkes expressed his views to the court. After a lengthy discussion between Sheriff Jewkes and the court. Motion was made by Paul Davis seconded by Charles Still to advertise for bids for commissioner vehicles. Commissioner J.W. Meadows abstained. Bids will open November 14, Motion carried

Motion by Paul Davis seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve the placing of a war memorial from the Old East MT. School to the Court house lawn. Motion also included that the monument be restored and maintained by the East Mt. ex-students. Motion Carried.

Motion by J.W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson to accept the low bid of \$10,732.00 dollars from Southwestern Insurance Assoc. of Austin, Texas for the county fleet and equipment insurance contract, for one year. Other bids submitted were from Terry's Insurance and Brownrigg Agency. Motion carried. Copy attached.







The intangibles (bank stock) was placed on a supplemental list and submitted to the Appraisal Review Board after certification of Appraisal Rolls. A different formula for assessment was used since the courts ruled the "Bank Method" not acceptable. Each of the four banks protested and were represented at the October 11 meeting. The Appraisal Review Board voted five for - none against to "exempt" the bank intangibles for 1983 awaiting legislative action next year.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Upshur County did on this day accept with regret Mrs. Snow's resignation;


