Motion by J.W. Meadows seconded by Delmo Lawson to approve the payment of the unpaid bills. Motion carried. Copy attached.



Formal notice is hereby given that GENERAL TELEPHONE COMPANY of the SOUTHWEST will construct a communication line within the right-of-way of a County Road in Upshur County, Gladewater, Texas as follows:

This cable will be buried on an oil county road (Camp Natowa Road). This cable will be buried no more than 5 feet into existing right-of-way and will be buried no less than 30 inches deep.
