Tom Wolfe of First Southwest Co. met with the court concerning the financing of the Upshur County Jail.


Motion by J.W. Meadows seconded by Charles Still to approve the payment of the unpaid bills. Motion carried. Copy attached.




Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by J.W. Meadows to advertise for bids on dump beds for trucks. Motion carried.


