




SPECIAL ROAD USE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between EXXON COMPANY, U.S.A. (a division of Exxon Corporation), herein called "Exxon," and the COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS,

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, for the purpose of the constructing the location and drilling and completing the Gladewater Gas Unit 18A-2 in Upshur County, the location of which is shown on Exhibit "A," attached hereto, it is necessary for Exxon to use a portion of one county road in Precinct No. 1 over which the Commissioner for that Precinct has jurisdiction and the obligation to maintain said road in good repair; and

WHEREAS, both parties are aware of possible damage to said road as a result of such use of said road, and Exxon desires to assume responsibility for such damage to the extent herein provided:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein stated, it is agreed as follows:

1. Exxon agrees that its contractors will use for the purpose above recited, only that section of the county road shown in RED on Exhibit "A," which section is hereinafter referred to as "the road." The term "the road" shall (for the purposes of this agreement) include any bridge or culvert located on or under said road. For convenience, the use of the road by the contractors will be referred to as Exxon's use.

2. Exxon agrees that such use will be made in such a manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on the road, so that the road will be open to travel by the public at all times.

3. Exxon agrees to reimburse Upshur County for the reasonable costs of materials for maintaining and repairing the road during the time that Exxon is using said road, to the extent that such maintaining and repairing are necessary as the result of Exxon's use of the road. Exxon also agrees to reimburse Upshur County for such costs incurred in repairing the road following completion of use of the road by Exxon as herein provided, to the extent that such repairing is necessary as the result of Exxon's use of the road as provided herein. The approximate cost of materials to completely resurface a county road is \$6,000.00 per mile. The length of road to be used by Exxon is about 0.75 mile. Therefore, Exxon agrees to reimburse the County for a maximum of its fair share of \$4,500.

4. During the time that Exxon is so using the road, if the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 proposes to perform any maintenance work or repairs on the road which said Commissioner deems necessary as the result of Exxon's use of the road, said Commissioner shall give notice to Exxon of the proposed action not less than forty-eight (48) hours in advance of the performance of said work. In such event, a joint inspection shall be made by an Upshur County representative and a representative of Exxon so that a mutual agreement can be reached, if possible, as to the cause of the need for such maintenance or repair, and the nature and extent of the necessary repairs. Upon completion of Exxon's use of the road under this agreement, Exxon shall promptly give the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 notice of such fact, and promptly thereafter, a joint inspection shall be made by an Upshur County representative and

a representative of Exxon so that a mutual agreement can be reached, if possible, as to the repairs which have become necessary by reason of Exxon's use of the road. Following each such joint inspection, the County of Upshur shall submit to Exxon a written estimate of the cost of materials for such necessary repairs. The notices herein provided for shall be given in writing, addressed to Exxon at P. O. Box 9003, Tyler, Texas 75711-9003, and to the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 at P. O. Box 730, Gilmer, Texas 75644.

5. Payment by Exxon hereunder shall be made upon proof of expenditures, with evidence as to what the expenditures relate, together with a written statement signed by the County Judge of Upshur County, Texas, that such repair work has been completed in a manner satisfactory to the County.

6. Nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver by the Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 of the authority granted him by Article 6717, V.A.C.S., but the rights and authority granted said Commissioner by the terms of said statute are expressly reserved by the Commissioner in the event Exxon fails to abide by the conditions herein stated.



The undersigned and each of them, severally and not jointly, represent and warrant that they, respectively, are the legal owners of the interest in the oil and gas and other gaseous or liquid hydrocarbons which are produced from the lease or unit designated above and particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, in the proportions shown in the Division of Interest attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "B", and subject to any conditions contained in said Exhibit "B", said Exhibits being made a part hereof for all purposes.

The addressee set out above hereinafter called "Operator" (whether one or more) until further written notice from Operator to the undersigned, or from the undersigned to Operator, is hereby authorized to cause to be taken the above described production, to receive payment therefor from the takers or purchasers thereof, and remit to the owners shown in the Division of Interest attached as Exhibit "B", in the proportions shown opposite their respective names, all sums received by Operator for same. Assignees of Operator may continue payment under this division order without the necessity of issuing new division orders.

For all gas taken hereunder, the undersigned will be paid the market value at the well or wells of such gas which for all purposes hereunder shall be considered the price received by Operator for such gas, under any presently existing or any future contracts for the sale of gas, at the delivery point, less, as operating conditions in Operator's opinion require, an amount sufficient to reimburse Operator for all costs incurred in making delivery of any such gas from the wellhead and shall include, but not by way of limitation, the costs of gathering, dehydrating, compressing, treating and transporting the gas.

For all oil, condensate, distillate or other liquid hydrocarbons taken hereunder, the price therefor shall be the same price received by Operator therefor at the well, after deducting therefrom a reasonable sum to cover the costs and expenses of treating and marketing such product. If, in order to market such products, it is necessary to transport same by truck or barge to a marketing point, then, in that event, Operator is authorized to deduct from the proceeds for such products the trucking or barging charges. Proper deductions will be made for water, dirt, sediment and other impurities and corrections for temperature will be made in accordance with established rules prevailing at the time and place of delivery.

Each of the undersigned whose interest shall hereafter vest in another not signing a division or transfer order agrees to hold Operator harmless from any loss in connection with such changes in ownership which results from Operator's reliance on the foregoing authorization.

It is understood that any vendee or assignee of any interest in the property covered hereby or the production therefrom shall take subject to the terms hereof and Operator shall not be bound by any sale or assignment of any interest in said property or the production of oil therefrom or the proceeds from the sale of gas sold or used off the property until written notice thereof shall be furnished Operator in the form of the original or a certified copy of the instrument by which said sale or assignment was made. Any change of interest hereunder shall be made subject to this division order and shall be effective at 7:00 o'clock A.M. on the first day of the calendar month following such notice.

The provisions hereof shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of all parties who execute this instrument, their heirs, successors and assigns, whether or not all owners listed execute same, and no subsequent change of ownership from that set out herein, however accomplished, shall have any effect to change the binding force of the agreements herein made with reference to said lease or leases or the said instrument creating said unit, as the case may be.
