Court reconvened in open session Thursday the 18th with all members present except Commissioner Paul Davis and the County Judge.



As of 6 April 1985 the city of West Mountain has been disincorporated by popular vote. The votes were canvassed 9 April 1985 and approved. At that time I so declared the city abolished. All funds and property are being turned over to you and your commissioner's court. Recommendations for disposal of said properties and funds are as follows:


One City Hall and Community Building; It is recommended the county exercise control and maintain said building. It will continue to be used as a polling place and community center.

Cash on deposit ^{4083.79 Pmt} ~~\$4137.79~~; \$698.00 of the total sum is Revenue Sharing funds. These funds were originally set aside for a ramp to be installed at the community building for the handicapped. It is recommended that the county use this fund to do the same.

Balance ^{3385.79 Pmt} ~~\$3439.79~~; It is recommended \$1000.00 be used by the county to pay any outstanding debts, to cover any expenses incurred in handling the change over and the balance to be used for street repairs inside the old city limits (not just Silk Tree Road).

Balance ^{2385.79 Pmt} ~~\$2439.79~~; It is recommended this amount be donated to the West Mountain Volunteer Fire Department. We feel this would be the most beneficial to the citizens in this area. Fire protection is a major concern. It is further recommended that, if the county does not wish to maintain the community center, that it be turned over to the Fire Department. The Department would keep the building for its original purpose.







SUBJECT: Proposed Scope of Services and Order of Procedure

In order to accomplish the task of determining the class of each County-maintained road in Upshur County and its length, KSA would require the following information, materials, and assurances and would proceed in the following sequence:

1. Court issues letter to KSA specifically instructing us to physically measure the length in miles (to the nearest tenth of a mile) and record the class of each road maintained by the County - all recorded by precinct.
2. The Court will provide KSA a County road map that clearly defines and shows each County-maintained road to be measured and classified, shows the County Commissioners Precinct lines (clearly defined along roads and at road intersections), and names for each road. The Court will also instruct KSA as to criteria to be used for road class determination.
3. We will prepare a project map from this information that will be constructed for purposes of conducting the survey and recording survey data.
4. We will submit the map to the Court, and each member of the Court will be asked to sign it, stipulating its accuracy, after necessary corrections are made in it.
5. We would then conduct the survey, record the data on a computer printout, alphabetize by road name (see attached sample) and on the project map.

6. Physical road measurement would be accomplished using a Roll-a-Tape Model 600 Road Wheel with bumper attachment, which would be calibrated and checked daily, both before and after measurements were taken.
7. The measurements would be spot-checked by vehicle odometer and against map distances to pick up inconsistencies. Such inconsistencies will be double-checked.

NOTE: The cost to the County for this survey would be a lump sum fee of \$2,500.
