10-24-88

Commissioners Court met in special session with all members present.

Mike Shiflett and Rex Hunt, with Shiflett Engineers met with the court to discuss the solid waste program Upshur County must implement. They offered their services as consultants if the county so desires.

Bids were opened for the Backhoe for Pct. # 4. Bids were from Byron Spencer, 18,000; Adamson Construction, 12,750; Randy Putman, 9,750; Upshur Co. Ford Tractor, 9,900 for a used one and 15,900 for a new one; Darr Equipment, 25,000; George P. Bane, Inc., Used-14,000-New-27,478. Motion by Tommy Eatherton seconded by David Loyd to table bids for further study. Motion carried, copy attached.

Bids were opened for the sale of two used motor graders from Pct. 3. One bid was received, from John Skinner who offered 7,000 for the one with a cab and 6,000 for the one without a cab. Motion by David Loyd seconded by Bill Loggins to accept the bid. Motion carried, copy attached.

Bids were opened for a dump truck for Pct. #1. Bids were: David White:11,000, Jack White:16,000, and F & H Construction 14,200. Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Bill Loggins to accept the bid from Jack White. Motion carried, copy attached.

Bids were opened for gasoline for county use. The only bid was from Young Oil Co. Motion by David Loyd seconded by Tommy Eatherton to hold the bids for further study. Motion carried, copy attached.

Bids for the pump and tank for the Sheriff's office use were opened. Titus Pump Service bid 9,023.00 for the tank and pump. Motion by David Loyd seconded by Tommy Eatherton to hold bids for further study. Motion carried, copy attached.

Skip Roark with Transport Life met with the court to discuss a program offered by Pro-American. He stated that the company is working with area hospitals and doctors on a pre-set cost plan. There will not be a fee for this unless the employee goes to a hospital that is a member of the group. Then the fee will be 4% of the bill. He stated that the savings should amount to at least 21%. Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by David Loyd to accept the proposal. Motion carried.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Bill Loggins to approve the special road use agreement by T. J. Dean Logging to haul logs on Boles Road and Pomegranate Road. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by David Loyd to approve the permit Application of Jerry Cannon to install a culvert within ROW of Pomegranate Road. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by David Loyd seconded by Tommy Eatherton to approve the permit application of General Telephone Co. to install a cable within ROW of Hilton Springs Road. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Bill Loggins to sign the release for Exxon stated that they have paid Upshur County 12,000.00 for repair of Bob-O-Link and Willow Oak Roads. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by David Loyd to approve the payroll changes of the following: Karen East, Karen Hall, Yolanda Young, Robert Nisbett. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by David Loyd seconded by Bill Loggins to approve the payment of the unpaid bills. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Eatherton to set the speed limit on Nightingale and Christi Roads at 35 MPH. Motion carried.

Motion by David Loyd seconded by Bill Loggins to approve the fire report as submitted. Motion carried, copy attached.

The problem with the bridges in the county was discussed by the court. Since so many of them must be replaced, it was decided that the auditor will submit a budget amendment and place \$25,000.00 in each commissioners budget. This will be used for bridge replacement only. Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Bill Loggins to do so. Motion carried.

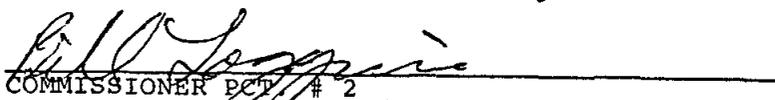
