AGREEMENT ON SERVICE DELIVERY FOR RUNAWAYS

This is an agreement on Service Delivery for Runaways between Carol Ammar CPSS IV, acting for the Texas Department of Human Services in Upshur County, Texas, and Ronnie Mitchell acting for the Juvenile Board of Upshur County, Texas, hereafter called the "parties."

The entity responsible for initial assessment for a runaway's service needs is the Upshur County Juvenile Probation Department, Upshur County Courthouse, Gilmer, Texas, 75644, telephone (214) 843-3083. (After hours 843-2541)

Each party agrees to contact the other party for investigation assistance if jurisdiction is unclear when abuse or neglect is suspected in a runaway case. Child protective services may call Ronnie Mitchell or Norma Tomlin at (214) 843-3083. Juvenile Probation may call Region 7 central intake at 1-800-544-9731.

For the purpose of this agreement, the terms abuse and neglect have the definitions given to them by Tex.Fam.Code 34.012. A copy of that law is attached. The parties acknowledge the system of priorities established by TDHS in 40 Tex.Admin.Code 49.505. A copy of this rule is attached. The parties acknowledge the system of priorities in TDHS Management Policy 1492, Ongoing Priority of Cases. A copy of this policy is attached.

Each party agrees to contact the other party before it closes a runaway case file in which both agencies have been involved. Juvenile probation agrees to call Carol Ammar (214) 843-5551 before a runaway case file is closed. Child protective services agrees to call Ronnie Mitchell or Norma Tomlin at (214) 843-3083 before a runaway case file is closed.

The parties agree to meet three times a year and review the sufficiency of community resources for runaways and discuss how additional volunteer or purchased community resources for runaways could be developed. The current voluntary community resource for runaways in Upshur County is provided by Sabine Valley Center, Project LIFT (214) 758-2471. Upshur County runaways may utilize the Youth Shelter, a program of Sabine Valley Center when temporary out-of-home placements are needed.

The parties agree that Ronnie Mitchell will give a copy of this agreement to the chief administrative officer of each police agency in Upshur County, Texas, and Carol Ammar will give a copy of this agreement to the chief administrative officer of each school district in Upshur County, Texas, and discuss with them to determine how it relates to their at-risk coordinators and court related student liaisons. The parties

agree to invite representatives from school and law enforcement agencies to their planning meeting and to discuss the reasons children run away, the problems of lost textbooks, the resources available, and the impact of runaway statistics on school improvement plans. The parties agree to meet again in ten months from this date to update this agreement.






