Commissioners Court met in special session with all members present with the exception of Judge Dean and Tommy Eatherton.

Dwight Brannon met with the court to request the cancellation of a subdivision know as the Brannon Addition. He presented copies of notices and publications pertaining to the cancellation. Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by David Loyd to approve this and return the property to acreage. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Stanley to pay the county' share of the fee for the 911 maps. The original plan was for the Appraisal District to pay half of the 5300.00 fee but they are only going to pay \$2000.00 so the county will pay \$3300.00. Motion carried.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Stanley to accept the bid from Victor Davis to buy the property the county has taken for past due taxes. This property belonged to Marie Collier. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Stanley to approve the payment of the county dues to the East Texas Council of Governments for 1991. This is for \$1716.00. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by David Loyd to approve the County Judge and Commissioners attending a meeting in College Station on Feb. 18-21, 1991. Motion carried.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Stanley to approve releasing securities to the First National Bank. Motion carried, copy attached.

Oley Sansom met with the court to request that roof repair be done the library activity building. Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Stanley to approve the repair and if there is not enough money in their budget to complete the job, to add the necessary amount. Motion carried, copy attached.

Paula Whorton, the Computer System Administrator for the Justice Center, met with the court and read a letter concerning Advantage Business Systems and the owner, Greg Manitol. She stated that the system is totally inadequate for the departments concerned. Also meeting with the court were representatives from the District Attorney's Office, The District Clerk's Office and the Office of Justice of the Peace, Pct. # 1. They all stated that they could no longer work with the system and requested the county to terminate Greg Manitol's system and to approve a new computer system for the offices concerned. This was tabled and will be taken under advisement.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Stanley to approve the District and County Clerk and one deputy from each office attend a meeting in Longview on Jan. 29, 1991. Motion carried.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Stanley to require all road crossings on county roads be done with a trencher instead of a back hoe. Motion carried.

Tom Oliver and Bill Webster, representing Calame, Linebarger & Graham, met with the court concerning renewing the delinquent tax contract with their firm. They stated that instead of the current two year contract with two year re-newals, the county accept a two year contract and after the two years the contract to be carried on a month to month basis. Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Stanley to approve this. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Stanley to accept a road into the lateral road system. The road is to be called Penguin Road-North. Motion carried.

As the events have unfolded for the past two weeks and after astronomical amounts of long distant phone calls, by myself, Paula Whorton and the Justice of the Peace Office, to Mr. Manitol, it is evident that Mr. Manitol is incapable of correcting the problems in which his business has created.

This has been a long known fact, from all of the Offices with the Justice Center that Mr. Manitol can not correct the problems with his Computer System.

Judge Garrison's Office was the first to receive a new computer system because Advantage Business System was not sufficient for his Department. Jo Ann Stocks, with Adult Probation joined in on the crusade for a new computer system because Advantage business was inadequate for their work load capacity and also the hinderence of problems Greg Manitol was not capable of correcting. Finally the Upshur County Sheriff's Department requested they be granted a new computer system because, Advantage Business System could not provide the maintenance, nor the knowledge nor the work power so that our Office could operate at full capacity.

I fully believe that the remaining Offices that are still using the Advantage Business System, Greg Manitol, have been patient through Mr. Manitols charade of dodging phone calls, inability to correct problems and Mr. Manitols dis-concern if the computer works at all. Everyone that is still on Mr. Manitols Computer System are ready to go back to the manual way of doing things because they are (2) two weeks behind on their work loads, because they cannot rely on Manitols word. Should this happen this will put Upshur County back into the Stone ages. Instead of going forward with technology, we will be going back 10 years. I believe this will be a devistating mistake for the County. Another reason this computer is a hinderence is because, since the work load is behind, example; warrants, warrants are not being cleared, this could cause a false arrest which could lead to a law suit against the County. A problem in which the County does not need.

I believe that the problem with Advantage Business System has reached its point of no return. Moral is so low because they can not do their work done. Moral is one of disgust and dissatisfaction.

I believe this problem is one of urgency. This problem needs to be addressed now. This problem needs to be alleviated.

Therefore I request that the Commissioners Court authorize this submission.

I also request that the Commissioners Court agree to give permission and approve a new computer system to the other offices whom do not have one.

CONTRACT FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXES

THE STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF UPSHUR

THIS CONTRACT is made and entered into by and between UPSHUR COUNTY, acting herein by and through its governing body, hereinafter styled First Party, and the law firm of CALAME, LINEBARGER & GRAHAM, 1949 South I. H. 35, Austin, Texas, hereinafter styled Second Party.

I

First Party agrees to employ and does hereby employ Second Party to enforce by suit or otherwise the collection of all delinquent taxes, penalty and interest owing to First Party and all other taxing jurisdictions whose taxes are collected by First Party. Current taxes falling delinquent within the period of this contract shall become subject to its terms when placed in litigation or on the first day of July of the year in which the taxes become delinquent, whichever date is sooner.

II

Second Party is to call to the attention of the collector or other officials any errors, double assessments or other discrepancies coming under its observation during the progress of the work, and is to intervene on behalf of First Party in all suits for taxes hereafter filed by any taxing unit on property located within its corporate limits.

III

First Party agrees to pay to Second Party as compensation for the services required hereunder fifteen (15%) percent of the amount collected of all delinquent taxes, penalty and interest for the years covered by this contract, actually collected and paid to the collector of taxes during the term of this contract, as and when collected. All compensation above provided for shall become the property of Second Party at the time payment of the taxes, penalty and interest is made to the collector. The collector shall pay over said funds monthly by check.

IV

This contract is drawn to cover a period of two years beginning February 10, 1991. Thereafter, this contract will continue on a month to month basis until such time as First Party notifies Second Party that it does not wish to continue the agreement. This agreement may be terminated by First Party by the giving of thirty (30) days written notice thereof to Second Party. Second Party shall have six months following termination of the contract to

reduce to judgment all suits filed prior thereto. In consideration of the terms and compensation herein stated, Second Party hereby accepts said employment and undertakes the performance of said contract as above written.

This contract is executed on behalf of First Party by the presiding officer of its governing body who is authorized to execute this instrument by order heretofore passed and duly recorded in its minutes.






