Commissioners Court met in Special Session with all members present.


Bob Bass of the consulting firm of Jim Allision Associates, met with the court to discuss re-districting of Precincts in Upshur County. Mr. Bass made computer presentations showing census bureau population figures and tracts. Mr. Bass suggested that now and in the future to use natural barriers, like county roads, rivers and so on as reference points. He suggested that County the size of Upshur County really needed only four Justice of Peace Precincts instead of five and only four Constables.

Further study will be needed to be done to determine how the black minority population will be affected by redistricting. Gilmer and Gladewater cities will also figure in the redistricting process, but in what way has not been determined.


