Commissioners Court met in regular session with all members present.

Motion by Tommy Stanley seconded by Gaddis Lindsey to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by David Loyd to approve the payroll changes of the following: John Alford, George Solois, James Griswold, Linda Palmer, Pam Wesson, Emma Smith and Nadra Smith. Motion carried, copy attached.

Motion by Tommy Stanley seconded by David Loyd to appoint 14 new members to the Upshur County Historical Commission. Motion carried, copy attached.

Several people from the Chamber of Commerce and the Historical Commission met with the court to discuss the purchase of the old post office building to be used as a museum. Bill Starnes asked the court if they would match private funds raised or pledge a specific amount to be used in the bid. He stated that \$6,400.00 had been pledged so far. Motion by Tommy Stanley to pass on this. This motion did not get a second. Motion by Judge Dean seconded by Tommy Eatherton for the county to pledge \$10,000.00. Motion carried. Mary Lee Baird then stated that this was not all the group expected of the county and they would probably ask for help with upkeep, utilities, etc. Gaddis Lindsey said the county cannot afford to spend a lot of money on a museum when they are in the process of trying for a prison to be built in Upshur County.

Members of the grievance committee for 1992 were drawn. Names of members were: Donald Puckett, Steve Murray, Wanda Roberts, David McQueen, Genice Bryant, Betty Cook, Jake Shrum, John Stewart and Lawrence Bell. Motion by Tommy Stanley seconded by Gaddis Lindsey to accept these members. Motion carried, copy attached. Members will be notified.

The beaver problem was discussed. Gaddis Lindsey stated that under state law if water stands on property 7 days then it becomes wetland. 





Fee Assessment for Beaver Control

The Texas Animal Damage Control Service has provided information and assistance in Texas for many years concerning wildlife related problems. The agency became significantly involved with beaver problems about 20 years ago. Since that time, the beaver problem has increased. According to our confirmed statistics (which are only a small fraction of actual damage), the actions of beaver cause an average of 3 million dollars of property damage in Texas annually. Along with the increased demand for our services, the Texas Animal Damage Control Service has had a reduction of personnel over the last several years due to inadequate state appropriations.

In the past, a county could enter into an agreement for a full-time Animal Damage Control Specialist (trapper) and pay \$900 per month. This individual handles both coyote and beaver work within the specific county. The present rate is \$1250 per month, but there is only a limited number of positions available. This assessment pays for a portion of the cost of the assignment with the majority being made up by federal and state funds.

Another popular approach to beaver control has been the use of our Wildlife Damage Control Specialists who handle complaints over a large area covering multiple counties. The agency has not charged for this service in the past. However, due to the increased demand, reduced personnel numbers, and inadequate funding, we must now assess a fee for direct control of beavers by all of our personnel.

A fee system will be implemented January 1992. We encourage you to participate in order to protect both county and private property from beaver damage. Two options are available to you in order to cooperate with the program. They are as follows:

I. An annual fee of \$3,000 payable by the commissioners court at the beginning of the Calendar year (January). This fee would entitle the county to direct beaver control by our personnel as the county can be scheduled. This option allows the most flexibility of geographic area and quickest response time for your area.

II. A weekly fee of \$350 or \$1250 per month, payable by the commissioners court. Requests for assistance will be gathered from citizens and/or local governmental officials and a date scheduled for operations to commence when enough requests are received for at least one week's work. The number of complaints to be handled per week will be determined by the Service personnel.

In most counties, we encourage the selection of Option I. Usually it is less expensive in the long run, allows for greater freedom to work within the county, results in faster response time, and allows for the maximum amount of property protection.

We hope that over a period of time, the fees charged will allow the implementation of a greater number of employees to handle this growing problem. For further information, please contact this office.
