



SPECIAL ROAD USE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between EXXON COMPANY, U.S.A. (a division of Exxon Corporation), herein called "Exxon," and the COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS,

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H :

WHEREAS, for the purpose of constructing the location and drilling and completing of the GLADEWATER GAS UNIT 16 WELL NO. 3 in Upshur County, Texas, the location of which is shown on Exhibit "A," attached hereto, it is necessary for Exxon to use a portion of the county road in Precinct No. 1 over which the Commissioner for that precinct has jurisdiction and the obligation to maintain said road(s) in good repair; and

WHEREAS, both parties are aware of possible damage to said road(s) as a result of such use of said road(s), and Exxon desires to assume responsibility for such damage to the extent herein provided:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein stated, it is agreed as follows:

1. Exxon agrees that its contractors will use for the purpose above recited, only that section of the county road(s) shown in red on Exhibit "A," which section is hereinafter referred to as "The Road." The term "The Road" shall (for the purposes of this agreement) include any bridge or culvert located on or under The Road. For convenience, the use of The Road by the contractors will be referred to as Exxon's use.

2. Exxon agrees that such use will be made in such a manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on The Road, so that The Road will be open to travel by the public at all times.

3. Exxon agrees to reimburse Upshur County for the reasonable costs of materials for maintaining and repairing The Road during the time that Exxon is using said road, to the extent that such maintaining and repairing are necessary as the result of Exxon's use of The Road. Exxon also agrees to reimburse Upshur County for such costs incurred in repairing The Road following completion of use of The Road by Exxon as herein provided, to the extent that such repairing is necessary as the result of Exxon's use of The Road as provided herein. The approximate cost of materials to completely resurface a county road is \$35,000 per mile. The length of road to be used by Exxon is approximately 0.6 mile. Therefore, Exxon agrees to reimburse Upshur County for a maximum of its fair share of \$21,000.

4. During the time that Exxon is so using The Road, if the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 proposes to perform any maintenance work or repairs on The Road which said Commissioner deems necessary as the result of Exxon's use of The Road, said Commissioner shall give notice to Exxon of the proposed action not less than forty-eight (48) hours in advance of the performance of said work. In such event, a joint inspection shall be made by an Upshur County representative and a representative of Exxon so that a mutual agreement can be reached, if possible, as to the cause of the need for such maintenance or repair, and the nature and extent of the necessary repairs. Upon completion of Exxon's use of The Road under this agreement, Exxon shall promptly give the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 notice of such fact; and promptly thereafter, a joint inspection shall be made by an Upshur County representative and a representative of Exxon so that a mutual agreement can be reached, if possible, as to the repairs which have

become necessary by reason of Exxon's use of The Road. Following each such joint inspection, the County of Upshur shall submit to Exxon a written estimate of the cost of materials for such necessary repairs. The notices herein provided for shall be given in writing, addressed to Exxon Company, U.S.A., at 3910 Brookside Drive - Suite 100, Tyler, Texas 75701-9422, and to the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 at P. O. Box 790, Gilmer, Texas 75644.

5. Payment by Exxon hereunder shall be made upon proof of expenditures, with evidence as to what the expenditures relate, together with a written statement signed by the County Judge of Upshur County, Texas, that such repair work has been completed in a manner satisfactory to the County.

6. Nothing herein shall be construed as a waiver by the Commissioner of Precinct No. 1 of the authority granted him by Article 6716, V.A.C.S., but the rights and authority granted said Commissioner by the terms of said statute are expressly reserved by the Commissioner in the event Exxon fails to abide by the conditions herein stated.

In over (3) years of use the Cellular Phones have never been mis-used or abused by the Sheriff's Department.

The average monthly bill for all four (4) phones, combined is about (\$75.00).

The County Auditor and the County Commissioners agreed on 10-11-93 to a Policy to require everyone that has a Cellular Phone to log all calls and to turn this log into the County Auditor, monthly for payment, this was done to keep one person from misuse of the phone.

Many times a citizen will call myself or the Chief Deputy to give us information on some criminal activity or on a wanted subject and do not want their name or telephone number known. We can not afford to log and make public, the names and numbers of these, people.

There are many people that have a police scanner and listen to the Sheriff's Office radio traffic.

The Sheriff needs to talk to the Chief Deputy, Jail Supervisor or other Police Agencies and to many other people about many situations that does not need to be on the radio.

I believe the policy adopted on 10-11-93 by the Commissioners Court on logging telephone calls, places an undue burden on the Sheriff's Department and will expose the names of citizens that are trying to assist the Law Enforcement.

The Sheriff will not violate the trust that these citizens place in us by logging their names and phone numbers.

On 10-14-93 the Sheriff had these (4) four phones disconnected and they will be stored in the Property Room of the Upshur County Sheriff's Department.



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### ADDITIONAL HEALTH DATA COMMENT:

This product contains benzene. The OSHA Benzene Standard (29 CFR 1910.1028) contains detailed requirements for training, exposure monitoring, respiratory protection and medical surveillance triggered by the exposure level. Refer to the OSHA Standard before using this product. Repeated or prolonged breathing of benzene vapors has been associated with the development of chromosomal damage in experimental animals and various blood diseases in humans ranging from aplastic anemia to leukemia (a form of cancer). All of these diseases can be fatal. No birth defects have been shown to occur in pregnant laboratory animals exposed to doses not toxic to the mother. However, some evidence of fetal toxicity such as delayed physical development has been seen at such levels. The available information on the effects of benzene on human pregnancies is inadequate but it has been established that benzene can cross the human placenta.

This product contains n-hexane. Prolonged or repeated skin contact or breathing of vapors may cause nerve damage characterized by progressive weakness and numbness in the arms and legs. Recovery ranges from no recovery to complete recovery depending upon the severity of the nerve damage.

This product contains toluene. Toluene has been reported to decrease immunological responses in test animals. It has also been reported that when young rats were exposed to 1000 ppm toluene for 14 hours daily, for two weeks, irreversible hearing loss was detected. The same daily exposure to 700 ppm for as long as 16 weeks was without effect. Since the level necessary to produce hearing loss is greater than 7 times the 1987-88 ACGIH TLV for toluene, worker exposures at or below 100 ppm is not expected to cause any adverse effect. There are also reports that chronic abusers (glue sniffers, solvent huffers) of solvents containing toluene have suffered liver, kidney and brain damage. Scientific studies on toluene have failed to demonstrate birth defects in rats and mice. However, toluene has been shown to cause delayed growth and extra ribs in the offspring of rats and mice at inhaled doses (266-399 ppm) that were non-toxic to the mother. Toluene has not conclusively been shown to cause adverse reproductive effects in humans.

This product contains xylene, a chemical that has been reported to cause developmental toxicity in rats and mice exposed by inhalation during pregnancy. Xylene has given negative results in several mutagen testing assays including the Ames assay. In a cancer study sponsored by the National Toxicology Program (NTP), technical grade xylene gave no evidence of carcinogenicity in rats or mice dosed daily for two years.

This product contains methyl tert butyl ether (MTBE). Most mutagenicity data on MTBE, except for the in vitro mouse lymphoma test, indicate that it is not mutagenic. MTBE caused birth defects in mice exposed to 8,000 ppm throughout pregnancy. No birth defects were observed in mice at 1,000 ppm or in rats or rabbits at any dose of MTBE. These results suggest that the risk of birth defects in humans from MTBE is negligible at the anticipated exposure concentrations.

Whole gasoline exhaust was reviewed by the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) in their Monograph Volume 46 (1989). Evidence for causing cancer was considered inadequate in animals and inadequate in humans. IARC placed whole gasoline exhaust in Category 2B, considering it possibly carcinogenic to humans.
