Commissioner Court met in Special Session. All members present.

Motion by David Loyd seconded by Tommy Eatherton to approve minutes of previous meeting dated 1-24-1994. Motion carried.

At the request of Commissioners Court, Jimmy Stanley, Building Contractor, met with court to discuss the Rock Building. Court had requested survey of the county owned building, which is 60 years old. Mr. Stanley stated building was in very deteriorated condition. Total renovation would cost as much as a new building. Estimate cost for 10,000 square foot building would be between \$250,000. and \$300,000. No action was taken at this time.

At 9:10 Commissioner Court went into Executive Session.

Commissioner Court reconvened at 9:21 into Special Session. All members present.

Judy Lawson, President of Concerned Property Owners of Raintree Lakes, met with court to discuss roads at Raintree Lakes. Ms. Lawson stated that the roads were in very poor condition and they can find no one who claims ownership of roads. Commissioner David Loyd stated that the County cannot do any work on roads unless the roads are accepted and placed into the County Lateral Road System as it is illegal to repair private roads. Commissioner Eatherton suggested they find out who legally owns roads and have them to donate roads to county. Also if they could get approval from District Attorney on the roads, he would do what he could to repair roads. No action taken at this time.
