

Commissioner Court met Special Session. All members present except Judge Everett Dean and Commissioner David Loyd. In the absence of Judge Dean, Commissioner Tommy Stanley presided.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Eatherton to approve minutes of previous meeting dated 5-31-1994. Motion carried.

Upshur County Justices of the Peace met with Court to discuss changing Precinct 2 and Precinct 4 boundary lines. This change will cause the Justice Center to be in Precinct 4. The J.P.s stated that they felt like the lines could be moved and that they will work together. J.P. elect Wanda Coston then stated that she was thinking about buying a building in Diana that she could renovate into an office. J.P. Crow also discussed his office and made mention the County leasing it from him. It was then stated by County Auditor that the county paid insurance on his building. Gaddis Lindsey stated that the County may be able to give each J.P. an allowance for their office. Tommy Stanley made the suggestion of a new building that will house offices for all J.P.'s and Constables. Further discussion will be brought up at a later date. No action taken at this time.

Motion by Gaddis Lindsey seconded by Tommy Eatherton to hold paying bills to Special Prosecutor and Special Investigators. Motion carried.
