SUBJECT: Disposition and future use of the old Gilmer National Bank building, which has been donated to Upshur County.

On May 2, 1995, the Commissioners Court received a letter stating that the board of directors of Gilmer National Bank had voted unanimously to donate the building to Upshur County. The letter expressed the board's desire that the building and grounds be used to the best advantage in the service of Upshur County citizens. The appraised value of the building and grounds was listed at \$330,000.

Dear Tommy:

The authority that I was able to find regarding the County Judge's power and authority over a public meeting, it seems to me would extend from his position as the presiding officer of Commissioner's Court under Article 5, Section 18 of the Texas Constitution wherein the County Judge is named as the presiding officer of the County Commissioners. Therefore, he would have the normal duties that would be expected of a presiding officer in that he would basically run the meetings. He is also named as the presiding officer in Chapter 81.001 of the Local Government Code. Again, the specific authority or duty seems to lack a certain amount of definition under that statute as it relates to the judge's authority. Since all persons have a right of free speech under the first amendment of the U. S. Constitution and similar provisions in the State Constitution, normally government can only control speech for appropriate reasons. Obviously, at a meeting everybody cannot speak at once, therefore; speech can be controlled in some fashion. Also, civil actions such as slander and libel have always been somewhat of a limitation on free speech. Further, government has historically been allowed to control certain types of obscene speech and so forth. Quite frankly, those complicated matters regarding free speech take up a good part of a semester at law school and we really only scratched the surface in that length of time. However, generally all citizens have a right of free speech which can only be regulated by the government for appropriate reasons. As these general concepts apply to the questions you've asked regarding the authority of the county judge to set a public hearing and state that no member of the Commissioner's Court can express an opinion, it would seem to me that the rules of this particular public hearing should be set by whatever was voted on and passed in the Commissioner's Court to set the hearing. Simply stated, if the motion that was adopted by the Commissioner's Court provides that as part of the rules of the public hearing that no member of the court would express an opinion, then I would certainly think that it would be appropriate and

enforceable by the County Judge as the presiding officer. On the other hand, if that was not part of what was adopted by Commissioner's Court, I don't see that the County Judge should on his own regulate the meeting in that fashion. Again, I would think that as presiding officer of Commissioner's Court he could impose reasonable limitations or rules regarding the public hearing that might not be specifically set out but it seems to me that it would be a much better idea for a clarity if the minutes of the Commissioner's Court meeting in which this particular public hearing was set were consulted to determine the specific intent of the motion that was passed. I have provided a copy of this memo to all the Commissioners as well as the county judge so that hopefully this issue can be resolved and I would be more than happy to address the matter further if anyone should request such information.

I was unable to attend the public hearing that was held in Gilmer recently concerning the use of the old Gilmer National Bank Building.

I would like to express to you as County Judge and Commissioners my opinion about the use of the bank building. On three occasions I have had to go the County tax accessor-collector to conduct business. In January, I went to the tax assessor-collector's office to pay my taxes. The line at that time was out into the hall of the courthouse. After getting into the office to conduct my business, the space was crowded. In March, I went to purchase registration stickers for two of our four vehicles. Again the line was long and after standing in line for 15 minutes or more, I left. On the third occasion, I experienced another long line.

During my visits to this office in the Upshur County Courthouse I observed that several elderly people were having trouble walking up the steps at the courthouse and then the stairs inside the courthouse.


I would urge you to let the TAX ACCESSOR-COLLECTOR for Upshur County move his office to the old Gilmer National Bank Building. By doing this, there

Dear Judge and Commissioners,

I attended the public hearing concerning the property DeScher County acquired from Limer National Bank, but did not state my opinion at the time. Frankly, there were a lot of unanswered questions in my mind, and I was unaware that they could not be satisfied under the format. I still think that the public should have been presented with rough estimates of how much it would cost to remodel the bank building should the Tax Office be permitted to move into it, as well as more realistic figures should it be decided to build a new building on the drive-in lot. I have serious doubts as to whether a parking lot could be considered a foundation for a substantial building.

I listened to all who chose to speak, and since have weighed all that I understood to be stated. I can see the merits of a sale to the Appraisal District as far as the debt is concerned, but feel that this route is a stop-gap measure, and what is lacking is long range planning. Whether the tax-payers like it or not, there is a need for more space for several offices or departments that can only be satisfied by building, and though the Court may dislike being in the real-estate business, the purchase of real estate is a necessary first step. The acquisition of the additional
