


ATTENDANCE SHEET PLACED INTO MINUTES FOR MATTER OF RECORD





I apologize for the delay in responding to your letter of June 20, 1996 requesting my opinion on questions that were brought up in Commissioners Court. I have been busy with several jury trials and unfortunately these matters have to fall at the bottom of the stack.

Question #1.

Can Upshur County maintain a tax collector and auto registration sub-station of the tax assessor and collectors office in an adjacent county (Gregg County) and also the City of Gladewater?

Answer #1.

There are several provisions of the law that allow for county facilities to exist or branch offices to exist in other towns or areas of the county other than the county seat itself, but they are extremely limited and under no provision that I can find allow for the establishment of any such office outside the county itself. Therefore, the short answer is no. I do not believe the Tax Collector and Auto Registration sub-station could be set up in Gregg County. I think it could be set up in Gladewater somewhere but it would have to be in Upshur County, and of course the practical problem in that matter is that the primary business in Gladewater is in Gregg County. If there could be an appropriate location in Upshur County in Gladewater, I see no legal reason why a sub-station or branch office could not be established.

Question #2.

Can Upshur County do free of charge or interlocal agreement work for the Upshur County Appraisal District?

Answer #2.

A brief review of Section 601 of the Texas Tax Code indicates that the appraisal district is a political subdivision of the State. Therefore, the County, as far as I know, can enter

into an interlocal agreement for work in the same form or fashion as it can with a State Political Subdivision or any other county or any city. Therefore, the short answer is yes, but I'm not sure about free of charge. That concerns me a little bit. I see no problem with an appropriate interlocal agreement being established.



FOR PIPE LINES CROSSING IN BORED HOLES
AND PLACED PARALLEL TO COUNTY ROADS

GENERAL NOTE: The construction of this project shall follow "The Upshur County Road and Bridge Department Standard Specifications" with respect to barricades, flagmen, flares, warning signs, and all responsibility for complaints or damage suits by the traveling public and adjacent property owners.

1. Excavation material shall not be placed on the road shoulders or traffic lanes or in ditches where drainage would be impaired. When excavation is permitted near the roadway where, in the opinion of the County, the support of the oil road structure is endangered, sheeting, cribbing or other measures shall be taken to prevent damage to the roadway or the creation of traffic hazard.
2. All excavations shall be backfilled in a neat and workmanlike manner and all disturbed areas shall be restored to a condition comparable to the original condition. Backfill material shall be consolidated to a density comparable to of the adjacent undisturbed material, replacing all of the excavated material except that displaced by the pipe. The degree of compaction shall be such as to prevent future settlement. Excess material displaced by the pipe shall be removed from the right-of-way or otherwise disposed of to the satisfaction of the county's representative. 





SPECIAL ROAD USE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between EXXON COMPANY, U.S.A. (a division of Exxon Corporation), herein called "Exxon," and the COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS,

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H:

WHEREAS, for the purpose of constructing the location and drilling and completing of the GLADEWATER GAS Unit 10 WELL NO. 3 in Upshur County, Texas, the location of which is shown on Exhibit "A," attached hereto, it is necessary for Exxon to use a portion of the county road in Precinct No. 3 over which the Commissioner for that precinct has jurisdiction and the obligation to maintain said road(s) in good repair; and

WHEREAS, both parties are aware of possible damage to said road(s) as a result of such use of said road(s), and Exxon desires to assume responsibility for such damage to the extent herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein stated, it is agreed as follows:

1. Exxon agrees that its contractors will use for the purpose above recited, only that section of the county road(s) shown in red on Exhibit "A," which section is hereinafter referred to as "The Road." The term "The Road" shall (for the purposes of this agreement) include any bridge or culvert located on or under The Road. For convenience, the use of The Road by the contractors will be referred to as Exxon's use.
2. Exxon agrees that such use will be made in such a manner as not to block or interfere with other traffic on The Road, so that The Road will be open to travel by the public at all times
3. Exxon agrees to reimburse Upshur County for the reasonable costs of materials for maintaining and repairing The Road during the time that Exxon is using said road, to the extent that such maintaining and repairing are necessary as the result of Exxon's use of The Road. Exxon also agrees to reimburse Upshur County for such costs incurred in repairing The Road following completion of use of The Road by Exxon as herein provided, to the extent that such repairing is necessary as the result of Exxon's use of The Road as provided herein. The approximate cost of materials to completely resurface a county road is \$35,000 per mile. The length of road to be used by Exxon is approximately 3 miles. Therefore, Exxon agrees to reimburse Upshur County for a maximum of its fair share of \$105,000
4. During the time that Exxon is so using The Road, if the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 3 proposes to perform any maintenance work or repairs on The Road which said Commissioner deems necessary as the result of Exxon's use of The Road, said Commissioner shall give notice to Exxon of the proposed action not less than forty-eight (48) hours in advance of the performance of said work. In such event, a joint inspection shall be made by an Upshur County representative and a representative of Exxon so that a mutual agreement can be reached, if possible, as to the cause of the need for such maintenance or repair, and the nature and extent of the necessary repairs. Upon completion of Exxon's use of The Road under this agreement, Exxon shall promptly give the County Commissioner of Precinct No. 3 notice of such fact; and promptly thereafter, a joint inspection shall be made by an Upshur County representative and a representative of Exxon so that a mutual agreement can be reached, if possible, as to the repairs which have become necessary by reason of Exxon's use of The Road. Following each such joint inspection, the County of Upshur
