(a) In each county there is a salary grievance committee composed of the county judge and:

(1) the sheriff, county tax assessor-collector, county treasurer, county clerk, district clerk, county attorney or criminal district attorney, and the number of public members necessary to provide nine voting members; or

(2) nine public members, if the commissioners court votes in January each year to have nine public members.

(b) The county judge is chairman of the committee, but is not entitled to vote.

(c) Public members must be residents of the county.

§ 152.015. Selection and Term of Public Members on Grievance Committee

(a) The public members of the salary grievance committee shall be selected at a meeting of the court in January each year.

(b) Before the meeting, the county clerk shall place on a separate slip the name of each person who served on a grand jury in the county during the preceding calendar year. At the meeting the slips shall be folded, placed in an appropriate container, and mixed. The county judge shall draw at random a number of slips equal to the number of public members needed for the committee and shall announce the names on the slips. A person whose name is drawn becomes a member of the committee on submitting written acceptance to the clerk. If a person refuses or is unable to serve, a replacement shall be selected at the next regular or called commissioners court meeting by random selection of a slip from the remaining slips. This process shall be repeated until the required number of public members is selected.

(c) A public member serves until a successor is appointed the following January.

(d) A vacancy in a public member position shall be filled for the unexpired part of the term by random selection of a slip from the remaining slips at a meeting of the commissioners court.

(a) An elected county or precinct officer who is aggrieved by the setting of the officer's salary or personal expenses may request a hearing before the salary grievance committee before the approval of the county's annual budget. The request must:

(1) be in writing;

(2) be delivered to the committee chairman within five days after the date the officer receives notice of the salary or personal expenses; and

(3) state the desired change in salary or personal expenses.

(b) The committee shall hold a public hearing within 10 days after the date the request is received. The chairman shall announce the time and place of the hearing.

(c) If, after the hearing, six or more of the members vote to recommend an increase in the officer's salary or personal expenses, the committee shall submit its recommendation to the commissioners court in writing. If six to eight members vote to recommend the increase, the commissioners court shall consider the recommendation at its next meeting. If nine members vote to recommend the increase and sign the recommendation, the commissioners court shall include the increase in the budget before the budget is filed and the increase takes effect in the next budget year.

(d) The committee's authority is limited to the consideration of increases in the salaries or personal expenses of county and precinct officers. The committee may not set policy of the county or add new items to a proposed county budget.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL EMERGENCY MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT

STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF GREGG

WHEREAS, Texas law authorizes local governments to contract with each other to provide services, and

WHEREAS, Texas law and state policy also provides for certain reimbursements or financial aid to local government for certain disasters or emergency conditions and

WHEREAS, The County of Gregg finds it to be in its best interest to have such mutual aid agreements with other local governmental bodies in the state and region,

NOW, THEREFORE, In consideration of the above recitals and the covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The County of Gregg hereby agrees to provide such mutual aid as may be requested by a governmental unit, which has emergency conditions as defined by Texas Law. The aid rendered shall be to the extent of available personnel and equipment not required for minimum needs of the County of Gregg. The judgment of the providing entity shall be final as to the personnel and equipment so available
2. Personnel dispatched to aid another entity shall remain employees of the County of Gregg, but shall work under the supervision of the requesting entity. The County of Gregg retains the right to withdraw any and all aid rendered upon direction of the providing entity
3. The providing entity will provide a list of hourly rates and equipment costs, and hours worked for all such aid rendered to the requesting entity for all actual costs, and the requesting entity agrees to compensate such claim for costs incurred for reasonable and customary labor and equipment rates. Damage to equipment that is not related to performing eligible work, or damage that was reasonably avoidable is not eligible for reimbursement
4. The County of Gregg will maintain workers compensation coverage for its employees and liability coverage for its vehicles and equipment. Any uninsured or extraordinary expenses may be a part of claimed costs for reimbursement. The requesting entity agrees to maintain adequate liability insurance under state law and to hold harmless and indemnify the County of Gregg for any and all claims occurring while its personnel and equipment are working under the direction of the requesting entity. These indemnities shall include attorney's fees and cost that may arise from providing aid pursuant to this agreement
5. The purpose of these recitals is to insure that the County of Gregg is reimbursed all costs and assumes no additional liabilities as a result of this agreement. Neither party to this agreement shall be liable, for its failure or refusal to render aid pursuant to this agreement. The requesting entity shall have sole discretion to determine the manner in which such emergency aid may be used

Dear Judge and Commissioners,

I am enclosing three invoices which EnviroSpecialists previously submitted to the Court for approval and payment. As you can see these are amended invoices. I adjusted these invoices downward from a total of \$26,400.00 to \$23,500.00, for a reduction of \$2,900.00, to account for the storage time prior to November 8, 2002. This adjustment eliminates the storage charges for the time during which there was the most political uncertainty in the County and eliminates any question as to the necessity of bidding demurrage.

As we discussed weather was not the cause of the delay. If the delay was not due to weather, why was the material not utilized timely? What option was available to EnviroSpecialists? EnviroSpecialists could not dump the material on the road and remove the tankers, nor remove the tankers with the material inside. The County would have accused EnviroSpecialists of theft. ~~We also could not repurchase the materials because they were made specifically for the particular Upshur County roads.~~ My understanding from conversations with Mr. Cline prior to the Thanksgiving holiday was that from November 7, 2002 forward he was the only person in the County with authority to direct the application of the material and that he was aware of the location of the tankers. Demurrage is a common practice and charge in the industry. ~~Mr. Cline as an engineer, should have been aware of this common practice.~~ In this instance the demurrage should never have been incurred. It was a question of priorities by the road engineer, justified or not, that caused the demurrage.
